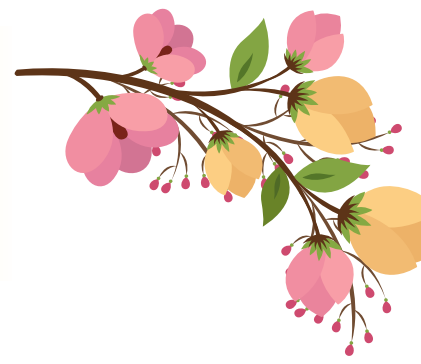

PASSOVER SCHEDULE 5785



Thursday, April 10th

Fast of the First Born Begins at 5:07am
Shacharit followed by Siyum to break the fast: 6:45am

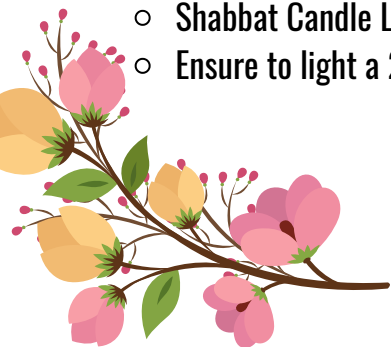
Search for Chametz / Bedikat Chametz Begins at nightfall / 8:21pm
Nullification as usual for the night of the bedika.
We don't do bedika on Shabbat since it's meant to be done with a candle or flashlight.

Friday, April 11th (Erev Shabbat)

Sale of Chametz must be completed.
Burn Chametz by 12:10pm
We can't burn the chametz on Shabbat (erev Passover) so we do it today.

Pre-Passover and Shabbat Prep

- It is best to prepare all the seder needs, including the seder plate, before Shabbat in order to start the seder promptly. This is because one is not allowed to prep from Shabbat to Yom Tov.
- If necessary, the prep can be done on Yom Tov except: a. Anything that requires grating should be done with a shinui, a backhanded manner and any food roasted on Yom Tov needs to be eaten on Yom Tov.
- Since it is forbidden to eat matza on Erev Pesach so that it is appetizing to us at the Seder, we have two options for our Shabbat meals:
 - Entirely Kosher for Passover and have Egg Matzah as bread. This would require eating a significant amount of Egg Matza - the volume of four eggs.
 - Entirely Kosher for Passover BUT have challah rolls for bread. In this case, be careful to keep any chametz (including crumbs) self contained and away from Passover dishes, by eating it in a napkin, on disposables or not over the table. After eating the bread, anything remaining is disposed off and you continue with your regular Kosher for Passover meal. It's helpful to pre-plan so as not to have much left over which would make it difficult to dispose of.
- Shabbat Evening: Mincha & Kabbalat Shabbat 7:00 pm
 - Shabbat Candle Lighting 7:30pm (6:34pm earliest)
 - Ensure to light a 24 hour+ candle for Yom Tov on Saturday night

Shabbat, April 12th: Shabbat Hagadol & Erev Passover

Shacharit 9:00 a.m.

Latest time to eat Chametz 11:02am

Latest time for nullifying Chametz: 12:09pm

Special Instructions for the Shabbat of the Eve of Passover

- Do rest up / do not prepare from Shabbat to Passover.
- **Shabbat meals:** either have an early Shabbat lunch with rolls (being careful to keep the chametz away from any Passover dishes and food) or if you eat egg-matza, you can do so at the regular time.
- **Finish eating chametz** by the end of the fourth halachic hour (11:02am) and say the nullification by the end of the fifth halachic hour (12:09pm)
- To dispose of chametz, flush it down the toilet.
- **Third meal:** either have a meal with bread before Chametz becomes prohibited OR have a third meal later. It is good to limit ones eating a few hours before the end of Shabbat as to enter the Seder with an appetite

Yom Tov Ma'ariv 7:54 pm

Motzei Shabbat and Passover Night

To perform any seder prep and melacha, say Baruch Ha'Mavdil Bein Kodesh L'Kodes, Blessed is He who distinguishes between the Holy and the Holy. Formal Havdallah will be recited later over Kiddush

Havdalla candle- Two matches or two candles can be used by bringing them together for the bracha
